

Audrey Moores is an Associate Professor of Chemistry at McGill Chemistry, Tier II Canada Research Chair in Green Chemistry. She completed her PhD from the Ecole Polytechnique, France in 2005, under the supervision of Prof. Pascal Le Floch. She was a post-doctoral fellow at Yale University in 2006 under the guidance of Prof. Robert H. Crabtree. She has served as co-associate director of the Center for Green Chemistry and Catalysis, a strategic cluster funded by the Le Fonds de recherche du Québec — Nature et technologies (2012-2016) and is in the program committee of the CREATE in Green Chemistry (2012-present). She has been an associate editor for the journal *RSC Advances* (2015-2016) and has joined the associate editorship of *ACS Sustainable Science and* 

*Technology* in the fall 2016. She is the scientific director in the board of GreenCenter Canada, an Ontario-based non-for-profit tech-transfer center.

She has co-created and co-organized for 3 years a workshop on Sustainable innovation through green chemistry. In 2011, she was awarded a Science Communication Fellowship for Green Chemistry by Environmental Health News and Advancing Green Chemistry. In 2014, she received an Outside Quebec Exchange Professorship, awarded by Quebec, in support for a 2 month visit at Princeton University and a CNC-IUPAC travel award in 2016.
