LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS	
Language Requirements	<p>Exchange students do not have to pass an official language examination in French in order to qualify for enrollment at UPJV. We do, however, expect intermediate language proficiency in French <u>equivalent to B1 (ideally B2)</u> since not all departments offer courses in English. Please check with the departmental coordinators before you nominate the students.</p> <p>For students : B1 in French and in English For staff : B2 in French and in English</p> <p>For courses taught in English open to Erasmus+ students in all departments, the list is under progress and would be published in the website</p>
French Language Courses	<p>UPJV's Language Center (<i>Maison des Langues</i>) offers French language & culture courses in different levels for exchange students which can be recognized with 8 ECTS.</p>
